The Prime Minister participated in the events of the EuroMaidan Revolution anniversary

Rīga, 22 February 2015. Today Laimdota Straujuma, Prime Minister of the Republic of Latvia, participated in the events of the EuroMaidan Revolution anniversary together with the Presidents of Lithuania, Germany, Georgia and Poland and Heads of Government of Estonia and Slovakia; they took part in a procession in honour of the EuroMaidan and commemorated the dead victims by laying candles on the EuroMaidan square in Kiev, Ukraine.

The Heads of State and Government had a discussion with Ukrainian President Petro Poroshenko. The Ukrainian President explained the current situation in Ukraine and informed about the latest progress in the negotiations concerning the opportunity to deploy U.N. peace-keeping force in Ukraine.

In Kiev, Prime Minister Laimdota Straujuma also held a meeting with Giorgi Margvelashvili, President of Georgia; the officials discussed the Eastern Partnership Summit to be held in May, in Rīga, and the reform process in Georgia.
