Prime Ministers of Latvia and Ukraine discuss the Eastern Partnership Summit and the pace of reforms in Ukraine

Kiev, 28 April, 2015. Prime Minister Laimdota Straujuma and Prime Minister of Ukraine, Arseniy Yatsenyuk in Kiev today discussed the forthcoming Eastern Partnership Summit and the pace of reforms in Ukraine. The Prime Minister emphasized that Latvia and the European Union as a whole strongly support Ukraine on this path.

The parties discussed the current situation in the eastern part of Ukraine. The Prime Minister of Ukraine also informed about the political, economic and social situation in the country.

L. Straujuma highlighted the importance of the "International Support for Ukraine Conference", stressing Europe's practical and moral support. A. Yatsenyuk noted that this support is of great importance for the Ukrainian government, and expressed gratitude to the Prime Minister for participation.
